- 2. Adjst to proper height, joint the bracket, install on hanging scaffold. See the pic 2.
- 3. Fix inside chimney on hanging scaffold, enclose outside chimney on it at proper position, insert hook into bracket to fix outside chimney temporarily. See the pic 3.
- 4. Fix air outlet in the vent on hood's body, connect extensible pipe with air outlet.
- 5. Extend the hose out off hanging scaffold, fix hood's body on bracket. See the pic5.
- 6. Detach the hook, move outside chimney downward till reaching hood's body. Pay attention not to strike the glass. See the pic 6.

The screen shows Ξ when it's on. The indication lights are all on and will be off after 1 second. The buzzer sounds and the light of ON/OFF button turns dark.

ON/OFF (increase speed): Touch the button for 0.5 second, the ON/OFF button light turns on and the display screen shows i, and its gear 1. Notes: the "+" button turns on for 1 second and then turns off after every touch.

Touch the "-" button, the display screen shows 2, and it turns to second speed.

When it's gear 1, the display doesn't change when the "-" button is touched.

Thebuzzer sounds and the "-" button light turns off after 1 second.

When the range hood is working, touches the "+" and "-" buttons together, it turns to "Delay Off" function (The range hood turns off automatically after 5 min) and the number on the display screen flashes. Touch the ON/OFF button, the range hood turns off and the buzzer sounds.


NOTICE OF INSTALLATION

1. Before installation, please ensure the area is clean to avoid suction of the remaining bits of broken wood and dust.

2.It cannot share the same air ventilation tube with other appliance such as gas tube, warmer tube, and hot wind tube.

3. The bending of ventilation tube should be≥120°, parallel or above the start point and should be connected to the external wall.





A.To protect the main body from corrosion over a long period of time, the cooker hood should be cleaned with hot water plus non corrosive detergent every two months.

B.Please do not use abrasive detergent or deodorant for it will damage the body.

C.Keep the motor and other parts free from water, as this will cause damage to the appliance.

D.Before cleaning the appliance please remember to cut off power.

E.The carbon filter shouldn't be exposed to heat.

F.Please don't tear open the fixed bar around the carbon filter.

G.If the plug or cord is damaged, please replace it with special soft cord.

H. Cleaning and maintenance is not carried out by children without supervision.
